The number of sections increased from 2016=2017 to 2017-2018 (33 to 37). And by default, the enrollment increased from 663 to 734. The retention percentage of F2F decreased by 1% and the retention % of online increased almost over 3%. The retention percentage decreased by less than 1%. The success percentage for both F2F and online increased and the overall success percentage increase by a little over 1%. Both the FTES and FTEF+ have increased. We awarded 15 degrees, 4 more than previous academic year. Furthermore, we awarded 13 certificates, 5 more than previous academic year. This means that we awarded a total of 28 degrees and certificates.

b. If this year's figures for the program are below the set standard explain steps you will take to improve.

The F2F retention decreased by 1%. It is not a lot, but this issue used to be more evident on the online setting. We will continue the dialogue with our full-time and part-time faculty to find solutions to increase the retention numbers. Perhaps, more communication between faculty and students early in the semester to help students understand the expectation and support them more one-on-one if possible.

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IV. Focus and Engagement of the Program

a. Summarize major trends and opportunities as well as challenges that have emerged in the program

OPPORTUNITIES:

- 1. We continue to work with our local high schools to offer concurrent enrollment SPAN. The relationship with the concurrent enrollment faculty has worked very well.
- 2. Within the SPAN, ASL, and FRCH disciplines we have very involved and dedicated part-time faculty members whom do work without compensation such as COR modifications and SLOs assessment and reporting.
- 3. The Spanish Debate Team continues working closely with Cal Poly Debate Team in friendly debates and formal competitions.

CHALLENGES:

One of the major challenges is to keep all foreign languages disciplines moving forward with the support of only 2 full-time faculty members. This has caused a huge challenge for two full-time faculty members to do everything (teaching, planning, grading, SLOs lead, foreign languages scheduling, book requisition, curriculum modifications, program annual update, and committee work, etc.). It is better than two semesters ago when the second full-time faculty was hired. However, with our busy schedules and many responsibilities (Spanish Debate Team, etc.) at hand, it has been challenging to accomplish some of our programs needed updates.

b. List any (internal or external) conditions that have influenced the program in the past year.

INTERNAL CONDITIONS:

- 1. STAFFING: Fortunately, 1 full-time faculty member was hired in Fall 2017 which means that since then there are two of us working in the program needs. The SPAN program has found itself in a difficult situation in trying to staff all the courses because we do not have a big of pool of qualified part-time faculty available to teach. This has caused a huge challenge for two full-time faculty members to do everything (SLOs lead, foreign languages scheduling, book requisition, curriculum modifications, program annual updates, committee work, teaching, and debate team coaching, etc.) Consequently, it is very challenging to maintain and support other programs such as ASL and FRCH.
- 2. DESIGNATED CLASSROOM FOR SPANISH COURSES: The Spanish faculty had the following classroom as a designated FL classroom, C-36. However, during the restructuring of departments in 2008-2009, we lost this room, and since then, finding a viable classroom in which to teach our 5-unit transfer courses has become a challenge. The full-time Spanish faculty would like to offer students some consistency in terms of a physical place, as well as more favorable times and days for F2F scheduling. This will also allow us to bring alive this classroom with information and posters that can reflect the cultural aspects of the Spanish-speaking world. Furthermore, this can create a space for the Spanish Debate Team to hold their meetings.

EXTERNAL CONDITIONS:

1. Given our geographical location, we continue to have a difficult time finding qualified part-time faculty to teach our courses. Many of our former part-time faculty have moved from the area due to the budget crisis. We currently count with three part-time faculty only.
