

# CCPD Survey Spring 2024 Data Disaggregated by Employee Group





### Q3 - What is your primary assignment type?






#### Q5 - How long have you worked at the college?




# Q6 - How familiar are you with the Councils and Committees Pathways to Decisions (CCPD)?




# Q8 - How many councils or committees do you serve on?




## Q9 - Do you regularly attend council or committee meetings for which you are not a member?
