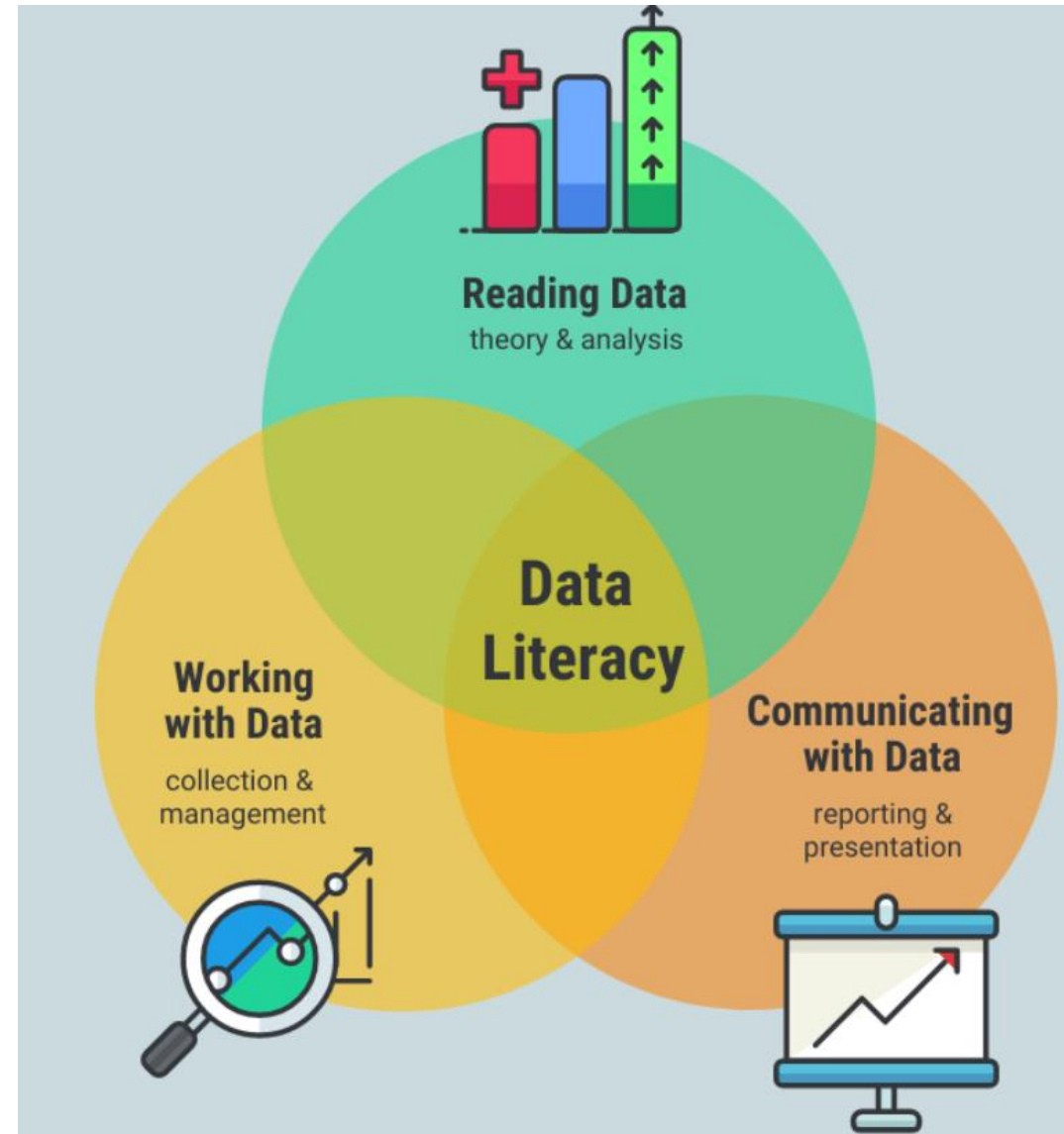
Why data?

Data literacy is the ability to read data, work with data, and communicate about data by putting it in proper context.

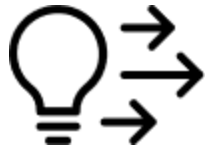


But, Erica, I don't do data because...

- Use data to inform development, planning, implementation



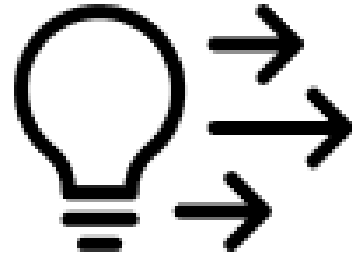
Solidify
