

Distance Learning Classes Internet • Hybrid • Video/OnlineVideo/DVD

Distance learning offers you the opportunity to earn college credits through self-paced learning that offers maximum flexibility. Some distance learning classes require no on-site activities; others do have required on-site attendance. Please be aware that the college does not provide hardware or software for home use. Check with your instructor to determine specific equipment needs. You should check the information provided in the orientation sections of the distance learning pages for full details.

You must provide the college with a valid email account to participate in distance learning classes.

Students enrolling in distance learning courses may register via WebReg, In-person registration, by fax, or by mail (**when enrolling in distance learning courses only**) by the deadlines listed below. All fees listed on page 9 are applicable to distance learning classes except the Student Center Fee. After registering, students enrolled in distance learning courses usually attend an orientation session where they will receive information regarding course requirements, examination schedules, instructor conferences, and review sessions. The dates and locations of orientation sessions are listed by each course. If a student registers after the orientation session, he or she must contact the instructor immediately. Email addresses are provided in the orientation section. If a message to the email address shown is returned

to you, please refer to the AHC directory (on the inside back cover) for department and faculty telephone numbers, or, check the college's Web site at www.hancockcollege.edu, *click* directory for email addresses.

Those registered students who choose to withdraw from class must follow withdrawal procedures if they do not wish to receive a failing grade (see page 20). For information about any of the procedures listed above, call ext. 3248. All add, withdrawal, and refund deadlines apply to distance learning students, regardless of where the student resides. Refer to the calendar on page 4 for specific dates/deadlines.

The enrollment size of each online class is limited to the same size as an on-campus class. This ensures that the quality of the teacher-student interaction is maintained.

Register early! Many classes are filled well in advance of the registration deadline.

Your complete registration packet needs to be received between the dates listed.

- Spring semester-length and Fast Track/Term 3 classes: **January 21-February 4, 2010** (*Must be received no later than 3 p.m. PST on February 4, 2010.*) To ensure processing, fax registrations must be received one business day prior to the end of late registration on Thursday, February 4, 2010.
- Fast Track/Term 4 classes: **January 21-April 7, 2010**

To register by fax or mail for Distance Learning courses, follow the instructions below:

- Apply online for admission
- Complete the credit registration form and the fees worksheet located on pages 24-25
- Calculate and submit the correct payment
- If your class is full, obtain an email from the instructor granting permission to add the course and submit it with your packet
- **Fax your registration packet to (805) 925-2093 only** during regular business hours (M-Th, 8 a.m.-6 p.m. PST; F 8 a.m.-4 p.m. PST). To confirm receipt of your fax registration and view your class schedule, log onto www.hancockcollege.edu and *click* on WebReg in the left column; log in and *click* on Schedule. Fax registrations are processed within four hours of receipt, during regular business hours.

Students often wonder if they have the computer skills to take a distance learning class. Recommended computer skills include, but are not limited to, the ability to:

- Use a browser (Internet Explorer, Netscape)
- Use word processing software (Microsoft Word, Works, or Word Perfect)
- Use email, including sending and receiving email attachments
- Perform basic file management including saving and moving files
- Find info on the Internet
- Complete online forms
- Download and use plug-ins

Your Personal Security as a Distance Learning Student

Allan Hancock College does not restrict enrollment in distance learning classes any more than it does in on-site classes. The law requires that we admit all qualified students. Blackboard

"Blackboard" is the course management system used by most instructors for instructional activities. Students must have direct, personal access to the Internet and a valid email account. The expectation is that the students use the computer themselves and do not work through an intermediary, except in the case of students with physical disabilities. Computers are available at both the Santa Maria campus and Lompoc Valley Center on a first-come, first-served basis. To access class pages via Blackboard, students may point their browsers to <http://blackboard.hancockcollege.edu> or go to the AHC homepage at <http://www.hancockcollege.edu> and click on **Blackboard**. Instructors will provide more information concerning access to Blackboard, such as login name and password, at orientations.
