The Santa Maria campus is located on California's beautiful Central Coast, halfway between Los Angeles and San Francisco. The 105-acre, park-like setting contains administration and academic departments housed in nearly two dozen buildings. The campus features a modern Student Center; the Sports Pavilion, including the fabulous Joe White Memorial Gymnasium; and the Marian and Severson Theatres, home of the Pacific Conservatory of the Performing Arts, the only training program of its kind in the country offered by a community college.



An extensive remodel and expansion of the college's Learning Resources Center, one of four original campus buildings, was completed in 2007. This includes a new, two-story addition, the Academic Resource Center (ARC), which houses student support operations such as the tutorial and writing centers, and the Ann Foxworthy Gallery.

The Community Education building opens in summer 2007. The new Science Complex is scheduled for completion in fall 2007. It offers modern lab and classroom space for life, physical, and mathematical sciences classes, in addition to health sciences programs including nursing, medical assisting, and dental assisting.

A \$180 million bond measure passed by voters in June 2006 will pave the way for additional new facilities and technology over the next 10 years.
