

## Summer 2017 Spectrum

Online class search is available now for summer 2017 Community Education (Spectrum) classes.

- Register online beginning May 15, 2017. In-person registration begins at 8 a.m., May 15, at Community Education (bldg. S) on the Santa Maria campus.
