

Hello colleagues:

We have been informed that the college should not expect to receive any H1N1 flu vaccines for employees before Dec. 15. Depending on supply, those quantities may be limited to high risk groups.

In the meantime, on Monday and Tuesday, Dec. 14 and 15, Health Services will open its vaccine clinics to high risk employees and non-credit students. These include:

- Young adults 18-24 years of age
- Individuals 25 years and older with chronic medical conditions
- Healthcare workers
- Persons who provide care for infants under 6 months

Time: 9 a.m. to 12 noon

Cost: \$9

Please note: While pregnant women and children are also high risk, Health Services does not have the vaccine without preservative (for pregnant women), nor the childhood doses, thus they cannot serve those populations at this time.

If more vaccine supply arrives, Health Services will open the clinic to a wider population as per County Public Health Department requirements.
