

Good morning, colleagues.

As mentioned in our update of Dec. 3, the Health Services office will be administering H1N1 flu vaccines to college employees and noncredit students on Monday and Tuesday, Dec. 14 and 15.

The cost for the vaccine is \$9. Health Services has set up an account with auxiliary accounting in order to collect the \$9 fee.

Those wishing to be vaccinated should

1. Call ext. 3212 for a vaccination appointment
2. Pay the \$9 fee at the cashier window (#4, 5 or 6) in building A prior to their appointment
3. Bring their receipt with them to their appointment

Vaccines will be administered from 9 a.m. to 12 noon to:

- Young adults 18-24 years of age
- Individuals 25 years and older with chronic medical conditions
- Healthcare workers
- Persons who provide care for infants under 6 months

Please note: While pregnant women and children are also high risk, Health Services does not have the vaccine without preservative (for pregnant women), nor the childhood doses, thus they cannot serve those populations at this time.

If more vaccine supply arrives, Health Services will open the clinic to a wider population as per County Public Health Department guidelines.
