

All Staff Update for May 13, 2009

Allan Hancock College is committed to keeping the college community informed about the H1N1 (swine) flu virus as it relates to our campus. This is a follow-up to information provided previously.

**Currently, we are not aware of any suspected cases of H1N1 flu involving either students or staff at any Allan Hancock College location. Classes and college operations are continuing as usual.** The college continues to follow the recommendations of the Santa Barbara County Public Health Department.

As an added measure of prevention, the Health Services office has purchased individual packets of hand sanitizer. Staff are distributing these packets to students on campus and have them available in the Health Services Office. Also, they have posted signage in all campus restrooms in Santa Maria and Lompoc reminding users of proper hand washing practices.

In addition, attached is a flyer that can be printed and displayed in your offices and/or classrooms that also provides tips for staying healthy and protecting others.
