To use the Guided Pathways dashboards click on the student journey phase.

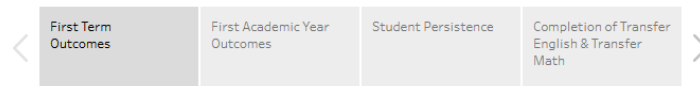

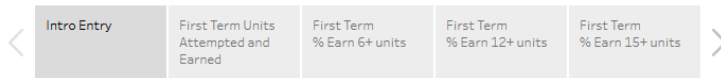
