

The catalog description is modified to include information that this is an introductory to administration of early childhood education programs course. The objectives are being modified and the course content is being updated.

MATH	Justification for modifications: The mathematics courses were reviewed for currency of course content as part of course and program review. Specific course modifications are noted below. Note: The combination of MATH 333 and 334 is equivalent to the Math 331 course.

	Modified prerequisite: MATH 331, or MATH 333/334 The objectives, textbook section, and prerequisite sections have been updated. MATH 333/334 is being added as an alternative prerequisite.	
MATH 105	Mathematics for Teachers	4
	Modified prerequisite: MATH 331, or MATH 333/334 The textbook is being updated and Math 333/334 is being added as an alternative prerequisite.	
MATH 121	Trigonometry	3
	Modified prerequisite: MATH 321 and MATH 331, or MATH 321 AND MATH 333/334 Math 333/334 is being added as an alternative prerequisite.	
MATH 123	Elementary Statistics	4
	Modified prerequisite: MATH 331, or MATH 333/334 One hour is being added to total lecture hours to cover the content and the lab hour is being removed; economics is being added as a valid discipline for teaching the class since we often have trouble finding instructors and many economists actually take more statistics courses than mathematicians do; Math 333/334 are being added as an alternative prerequisite; the content and objectives to match the C-ID and updated the textbook.
