

## HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS \$500 2024-2025 SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTION SHEET

- 1. Complete the application for the ASB Leadership scholarship. Be sure all information is completed on the application so that processing will not be delayed. If an answer is not applicable, write N/A.
- 2. A transcript of your high school record and One (1) Confidential Reference Form (completed by principals, guidance technicians, counselors or teachers) may be sent with your application or mailed to Stephanie Robb, Student Activities & Outreach Office at Allan Hancock College. Please ask the school to include your cumulative GPA on your transcript. All applicants must have a minimum 2.75 cumulative grade point average at the time of applying.
- 3. **Friday, April 26, 2024 is the deadline** for the complete scholarship packet to be received by Allan Hancock College Student Activities & Outreach Office. (Postmarked or hand delivered by 4:30pm)
- 4. It is your responsibility to see that persons filling out reference forms for you have returned them to the college by the deadline. Give them ample time to complete the form to meet the April 26th deadline. Check back to see if your referrers have mailed the forms for you. We recommend that you provide a stamped, addressed envelope for them to mail the completed reference forms to the college.
- 5. REQUIREMENTS: All applicants receiving the \$500 scholarship must complete the following requirements:

  Fall 2024- enroll in at least 8 units, including the Leadership 111 class in Santa Maria, which meets Monday and Wednesday from 11:30 a.m. 1:50 p.m. The first payment of \$250 will be processed if/when the student passes the Leadership 111 class with a C or better and obtains at least a 2.0 GPA.

**Spring 2025**- enroll in at least 8 units, including the Leadership 112 class in Santa Maria, which meets Monday and Wednesday from 11:30am – 1:50pm. The second payment of \$250 will be processed if/when the student passes the Leadership 112 class with a C or better and obtains at least a 2.0 GPA.
