KEY TERMS:

CASE: A person who has tested positive for COVID-19.

CASE RATE: Calculated as the total number of positive COVID-19 cases over 7 days, divided by the number of people (headcount) in the group being measured. Student headcount for Fall 2021 is 8,979 (all college locations). Employee headcount is 838, excluding student workers and temporary employees.

REPORT PERIOD: The seven-day period for which positive cases are reported by test date, and resulted in potential exposure due to their presence on campus during their infectious period.

INFECTIOUS PERIOD: This is the period of time a person with COVID-19 can spread the virus to others. It includes the two days before a person has symptoms through at least 10 days after symptoms start. For a person without symptoms, the infectious period is two days before the date the person tests positive for COVID-19 and until at least 10 days after.
