Use APA Style

2.

Limit title to 14 words with no subtitle title

3.

Include an abstract limited to 250 words

4.

Limit initial proposal to 2,000 words, including abstract

5.

Limit full submission to 20 pages, double spaced, using New Times Roman font

6.

Include references. These do not count toward the above limits.

7.

Provide a separate bio of no more than 150 words. Include name, title, department/division, and institution.

8.

Respond to all requested revisions and other requests within the established deadline.
