Approval of Minutes - July 13, 2016

Introduction of Visitors and Staff

Ms. Houghton introduced Natalie Rucobo, Advancement Specialist, and Terri Lee Coleman, Advancement Specialist. Mrs. Rucobo is working with the AIM fund as part of the Title V grant along with other stewardship projects including the President's Circle. Ms. Coleman, is working with the Ag Assessment grant, and other foundation stewardship projects as well.

Review of Financial Statements:

Director Walker reviewed the financial statements as submitted to the committee. He noted in reviewing the Summary of Portfolio Allocation that the \$250,000 gift from the Hansen estate was included in the 7/31/2016 balance.

Director Walker reported on the Finance Committee meeting of September 22, 2016:

- --Keli Seyfert, Auxiliary Accounting Supervisor, joined the Finance Committee and will be attending meeting to report on foundation financial statements.
- --The committee will continue to review the number of money managers and financial advisors for foundation investments to possibly streamline.

Investment Policy Statement Review

Director Walker reported that the Finance Committee reviewed and approved the Allan Hancock College Foundation Investment Policy Statement, which is annual requirement of the committee. However, he noted that as the new committee structure is updated this policy will be reviewed again to bring it more in line with foundation investment strategies. In addition, the document needs to be updated changing the "Investment Committee" to the "Finance Committee." Staff will note and include the bylaw amendment change of July 23, 2015, by the full board from "Investment" to "Finance" with the agenda packet for the November 2, 2016, quarterly meeting.

Endowment Funding 2016-17

Director Walker reported that the Finance Committee approved the proposed endowment funding for 2016-17. The staff recommendation was to fund the regular endowments for \$144,492; fund the Title III endowments for \$61,550; fund the quasi-endowments for \$84,400; and fund the STEM Federal Grant endowment for \$3,758 for a total of \$294,200.

Overview of Foundation Accounts

Ms. Houghton reviewed the process for depositing contributions to the foundation.

Contribution Pathway - Currently, there are four options to deposit a gift to the foundation. A contribution may be cash, checks, credit cards, or automatic bank withdrawals. The concern is that there is no policy in place for the deposit of foundation gifts, and relying on staff to make those decisions.

Endowment Pathway - There are currently five different endowment pools. Three of the endowment pools are presently receiving deposits. Two of the pools - Florence Young Quasi-Endowment and the Patricia J. Boyd Endowment - do not receive gifts. There is concern that there may be too many money managers making it difficult to manage foundation investments.

An overall summary will be shared with the board at the November 2 quarterly meeting. It was suggested that the Finance Committee might have as a standard quarterly agenda item to review all major gifts and identify where the funds should be placed.

Strategic Off-Site Retreat and Quarterly Board Meeting

The off-site retreat and quarterly board meeting is Wednesday, November 2, 2016, at the Radisson Hotel in Santa Maria. The timeline for the day will include the retreat from 8 a.m. to 12 noon that includes continental breakfast, followed by lunch, with the quarterly meeting scheduled from 1-2 p.m. Ms. Houghton reviewed the proposed agenda for both the retreat and quarterly meeting.

40th Anniversary of the Allan Hancock College Foundation

Ms. Houghton shared that the foundation is turning 40 in 2017, and the planning has started on branding and setting the stage for the college's 100th anniversary celebration in 2020. The Office of Public Affairs/Publications and Campus Graphics are creating a new logo to include "40". The foundation will explore a spring or summer event to promote the anniversary celebration.

Committee Fiscal Year Focus & Priorities for 2016/17

A proposed new committee structure was reviewed that includes the two-year goals outlined by President Moya last July. Ms. Houghton stated that staff have been assigned to help each committee. In addition, staff is recommending the foundation bylaws be amended to remove the Scholarship Committee and Nominating Committee as standing committees. Those amendments along with other proposed bylaw updates will be discussed at the January Executive Committee meeting. It's important that all directors participate and serve on one committee that will meet quarterly and report to the Executive Committee.

Subject: U.S. Department of Education Endowment Challenge Grant Title III Update and Recommendation	January 11, 2017

Background: In 1997, Allan Hancock College (AHC) was awarded a matching funds grant from the U.S. Department of Education's Endowment Challenge Grant Program - authorized by Title III of the Higher Education Act of 1965. The Allan Hancock College Foundation (AHCF) was responsible for raising the local matching funds. The grant is a 2-1 match where Title III provided \$500,000 and the match \$250,000 for a \$750,000 endowment. Because the federal matching funds were used to establish endowments, the AHCF is required for a term of twenty years to submit annual reports to the Department of Education and comply with specific federal guidelines, investment and expenditure of earnings guidelines. The expenditure guidelines state no more than 50% of the aggregate income earned can be used for operations and maintenance; administration; academic and support personnel; construction and renovation; community and student services programs and technical assistance; and other education-related activities. The starting date of the twenty-year term was established according to Title III guidelines as January 1998. The ending date of this term restriction is presumed to be upon notification of release to the AHCF from U.S. Department of Education after all reports have been filed and accepted.

For the last 18 years, the Foundation has consistently filed annual reports. Reports were accepted, without question or comment. However, after personnel changes in the Department of Education, AHCF was recently notified that the grant guidelines were not being met. It appears that approximately 65% of the proceeds (as opposed to 50 %) have actually been used. Foundation and College staff have reviewed how this might have occurred and the potential path forward.

When reviewing the funding for Title III scholarships and programs, the current fiscal year revenue less expenses should have been evaluated to determine the endowment value. It was discovered that the Title III endowment ending balance in the proceeds account was used. This has occurred since the inception of the grant reporting. In addition, the contact at the Office of Postsecondary Education, recognizing the lapse on their end, has indicated a willingness to work with the foundation by extending the term of the grant by 1 or 2 years. This will not impact future federal grant applications for the college and AHCF is listed in good standing. The grant guidelines state "if an institution expends more than is permitted it shall repay an amount equal to 50% of the amount improperly expended". Based on the last report dated June 30, 2016, the amount would have been \$67,057.

FISCAL IMPACT AND RECOMMENDATION

Foundation Staff recommends the following corrective actions:

- --Ensure only 50% of revenues are expensed used each year.
- --Evaluate growth of fund at end of the 2016-2017 fiscal year (a strong market would be beneficial).
- --Waive the 1.5% administrative fee transferred to the Foundation's operating budget (approximate loss of \$12,000 annually)
- -- Use Foundation Operational funds in lieu of Title III scholarship/program funds (approximately \$13,355)
- --Negotiate with Morgan Stanley and LPL Financial a lesser fee and/or discontinue accessing brokerage fees to Title III endowments and have the foundation operating budget cover the brokerage fee expense. (approximately \$8,500)

Total direct fiscal impact to Foundation for 2016/2017 operating budget is \$33,855. To balance this, Staff recommends a request to the district to forgive the Foundation's portion of the Executive Director's salary - \$50,000. Remainder of the funds can be used to augment activities for the 40th anniversary. If, at the end of 2017, market conditions reveal additional measures are needed, subsequent action can be taken at that time.

BACKGROUND

The foundation's Endowment Funding Policy currently states:

Review Date:

The review date shall mean as of June 30 of the year in which endowment

funding is to be awarded.

The date of June 30 was a Finance Committee decision in October 2011. Prior to this change, endowment proceeds had been historically captured on September 30th. However, in 2011, due to market conditions, the board voted to review earlier each year. While this decision may have had alignment benefits to the Foundation's fiscal year, it has also caused a significant lag in the time when a fund's corpus is captured on June 30, the transfer of the scholarship proceeds into a holding fund occurs in December, an announcement of the award is made in May of the following year and the actual distribution of the money to the student occurs August following the award announcements. This is a 14-month delay in which proceeds significantly increase and more scholarships could be funded/awarded. This year, approximately 12 scholarships did not meet the 103% endowment minimum value threshold – forcing a decision to augment funding for these scholarships and/or not award.

FISCAL IMPACT

Changing the capture date to November 30th of each year would allow for the maximum amount of time for proceed growth.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approving the change for the Endowment Funding Policy Review/Capture date annually to November 30th. The Finance and Executive Committees along with the full board would then review fund balances in January for approval of scholarship funding. Transfers would be made by June 30.

BACKGROUND

With the 2016 change in focus for the Pacific Conservatory of Performing Arts (PCPA) Foundation (returning to focus on the endowment), the PCPA Auxiliary organization is requesting the assistance of the Foundation to accept quarterly proceeds granted via a bequest from the Marian Mullin Hancock Charitable Trust. The Foundation will serve as a conduit on behalf of PCPA, which uses the funds to assist with student enrollment. Each quarter, the Foundation will serve as the 501c agent authorized to accept the funds on behalf of PCPA Auxiliary.

Due to the timing of the change in focus for the PCPA Foundation, there is a one-time shortfall in the time students need these funds. PCPA Auxiliary is asking the Foundation to loan the first quarterly proceeds so that students can immediately access these funds.

RECOMMENDATION

It is the recommendation of staff to approve the loan of funds to PCPA for \$18,662 through April 2017 so that student enrollment fees can be paid. PCPA is anticipating their next quarterly check by this timeframe and the Foundation loan can immediately be repaid. Unrestricted foundation funds from the Hansen bequest can be used for this purpose.

Each year the foundation reviews the endowment funding with the review date of June 30. The date each fiscal year determines the fund balance available for the funding of each endowment. At the Finance Committee meeting held on September 22, 2016, the committee approved funding the following:

- 1. Fund 52 of the 64 regular endowments for \$146,492
- 2. Fund Title III (\$13,547) and Non-fed Title III (\$48,003) endowments for \$61,550
- 3. Fund quasi endowments for \$84,400
- 4. Fund STEM Federal Grant endowments for \$3,758

The foundation's Endowment Funding Policy states:

Regular Endowment Funds (Permanent Endowment)

It shall be the policy of the foundation to annually fund its endowment commitment at a rate based on the following table:

It is recognized that the endowment value may be below corpus value and donations may need to be secured to fund endowment activities outside of the endowment until market conditions improve to a point that the endowment value once again exceeds corpus value

Staff will review an example of determining the endowment value and rather or not an endowment funds. A handout will be provided at the meeting.

The following regular endowments did not fund:

- 1. Robert E. Acquistapace Meml. Endowment, principal amount \$18,500
- 2. Chief Ron Bennett Memorial Endowment, principal amount \$36,840
- 3. Michael Bonaccorsi Memorial Endowment, principal amount \$39,200

- 5. Don & Gwen Harelson Memorial Endowment, principal amount \$10,000
- 6. Bob Isaacson Memorial Endowment, principal amount \$32,333

- 8. Lahr Family Endowment, principal amount \$21,500
- 9. Lola A. Dority Endowment, principal amount \$130,000

It is the recommendation of staff to amend the current operating budget to fund the above 9 endowments in the amount of \$500 each. The funding will provide scholarship/program funding to be awarded this year.

The increase to the operating budget would be \$4,500.

FISCAL IMPACT

An increase of \$4,500.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended to approve increasing the operating budget by \$4,500 to fund the 9 endowments that did not provide funding for scholarships and program funds.

Staff are recommending the following updates to Article VI – Meetings and to Article VIII – Committees. The board of directors approved the change to move the organizational meeting from February to July at its annual retreat last November. The updates for Article VIII (Committees) is to realign with the new restructure approved by the board last fall.

ARTICLE VI - MEETINGS

A. The annual meeting of the Corporation shall be held in Santa Maria, Santa Barbara County, during the **third second** week of **July February** of each year. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held quarterly at the time and place designated by the Board.

ARTICLE VIII - COMMITTEES

A. There shall be an Executive Committee consisting of the following persons: President of the Corporation; Vice-President of the Corporation; Secretary of the Corporation; Treasurer of the Corporation; Superintendent/President of the District; Past President of the Corporation; one or two persons serving as a Director by virtue of being a Trustee of the District (who shall be appointed to the Executive Committee by the Board of Directors); and, at the option of the Executive Committee, two additional members from the board of directors may serve on the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall have authority to act on behalf of the board in all employment and personnel matters affecting foundation employees. The Executive Committee shall have and may exercise all power and authority of the Board of Directors, except that the Executive Committee shall not have the power or authority to undertake any of the following actions:

- 1. the removal of a Director, or the filling of vacancies on the Board.
- 2. the amendments or repeal of Bylaws or the adoption of new Bylaws;
- 3. the amendment or repeal of any resolution of the Board;
- 4. the creation of **standing and** other **standing** committees of the Board without the express consent of the Board;
- 5. the expenditure of corporate funds to support a nominee for Director after there are more people nominated for Director than can be elected; or
- **5 6.** the approval of any self-dealing transaction, as such transactions are defined in Section 5233(a) of the California Non-Profit Public Benefit Corporations Law.

The Executive Committee, working in coordination with the Finance Committee, recommends the annual budget, reviews and monitors the foundation's finances and financial transactions, and provides for an annual audit.

At each meeting of the Board of Directors, the members of the Executive Committee shall report to the Board regarding all actions taken by the Executive Committee since the last prior meeting of the Board of Directors.

- B. With the approval of the Board of Directors, the Executive Committee shall appoint the committees and in addition shall appoint any standing special committees. as approved by the Board of Directors:
 - 1. The Nominating Committee is responsible for advising the Board on matters related to board development, for recruiting and nominating board members, for new member orientation and for recommending a slate of officers each year.
 - C. 2. The Finance Committee shall be a standing committee subject to the Brown Act. The committee shall review and recommend investment policies and actions. The treasurer of the foundation shall be the chair of the Finance Committee. The Vice President, Business Services of Allan Hancock College shall be a member of the committee.
 - 3. The Scholarship Committee oversees the Foundation's scholarship program, including but not limited to the solicitation of funds and the oversight of funding allocations.
- C. One member of each of the aforementioned committees shall be appointed chairperson by the Executive Committee, unless otherwise provided herein.
- D. Vacancies in the membership of any committee shall be filled by the Executive Committee. Members of all committees shall serve at the pleasure of the president, except as otherwise provided herein.
- E. For the Executive and Finance Committees, 50% of the whole committee shall constitute a quorum, and 40% of the whole committee shall constitute a quorum for **any special all-other** committees. The act of a majority of the members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the committee.
- F. Each committee may adopt rules for its operation not inconsistent with these bylaws or with rules adopted by the Board of Directors.
- G. Each committee will be composed of no fewer than three (3) members.

Vitae for Judy Frost – Updated 1/2017

Judy Frost became a company member of PCPA in 1991. Originally hired thru the Auxiliary Programs Corp of Allan Hancock College as PCPA Business Manager, in 1996 she was promoted to Managing Director – responsible for everything that ISN"T artistic or creative. In 2000 this position was reclassified as a college position at the Director level. Judy retired from this position at the end of 2006.

Judy attended California State University, Long Beach, and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Accounting. After working for Knott's Berry Farm as internal audit and accounting manager, she left the field of entertainment for the high-tech electronics industry. She was Division Controller for Computer Automation and later Computer Systems Company, a division of McDonnell Douglas. In 1984 Judy complete the course of study at Pepperdine University for a Master of Business Administration in Management.

Originally from Southern California, Judy and her husband Erik, relocated to Santa Maria in 1989.

As a contributing member of the Santa Maria community, she served as a steering committee member of the Santa Maria Affiliate from 1996 through 2003 and as a Trustee of the Santa Barbara Foundation from 2004 through 2012, and as Chairman of the Board of the Santa Barbara Foundation 2010 and 2011. She also served on the board of The Orfalea Foundation from 2010 until it's disolution at the end of 2015. Judy also served as a director on the Allan Hancock College Foundation from 2007 through 2015.

Currently Judy serves on the boards of the Santa Maria Branch of the American Association of University Women, the Pacfic Central Coast Health Clinics of Dignity Health, the Santa Maria Arts Council, and the PCPA Foundation. In 2014 she was appointed by the Mayor of Santa Maria, the honorable Alice Patino, to serve on the Community Block Grant Advisory Committee and will be completing the three year term in the spring of 2017.
