ALLAN HANCOCK COLLEGE FOUNDATION A REGULAR MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE Minutes of July 16, 2025 4:00 – 5:00 p.m.

A regular meeting of the Executive Committee was held at Allan Hancock College - Bldg. B, Captain's Room.

1. Call to Order

Foundation board member J. Dale called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

2. Roll Call

Executive Committee Members Present: Judith Dale, Erica Jane Flores, Mike Gibson, Tim Harrington

Executive Committee Members Absent: Debra Hood, Kevin Walthers

College Staff Present: Marisol Diaz, Jon Hooten

3. Public Comment – None

4. Approval of Agenda for July 16, 2025 (ACTION)

MOTION: On a motion by M. Gibson, seconded by T. Harrington, the agenda for the meeting of the Executive Committee was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

5. Approval of Minutes for March 19, 2025 (ACTION)

<u>MOTION</u>: On a motion by M. Gibson, seconded by E. Flores, the minutes from March 19 were approved by a unanimous voice vote.

6. Executive Director's Report (Information)

J. Hooten gave the committee an update on Hancock Honors planning and the Foundation's continued partnership with CoastHills Credit Union as the presenting sponsor.

7. Governance and Nominations (ACTION)

7.A Director Resignation – Debra Hood

J. Hooten presented D. Hood's resignation to the board effective July 16, 2025

7.B. New Student Representative – Annabelle Ruiz

<u>MOTION</u>: On a motion by E. Flores, seconded by M. Gibson, Annabelle Ruiz was approved as the 2025-2026 student representative by a unanimous voice vote.

7.C. 2025-2026 Slate of Officers

The board confirmed new officer roles, including president, vice president (with succession to president in two years), and treasurer, with discussion of potentially adding a second vice president.

MOTION: On a motion by J. Dale, seconded by M. Gibson, the 2025-2026 slate of officers was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

7.D. 2025-2026 Calendar of Meetings and Events

MOTION: On a motion by T. Harrington, seconded by E. Flores, the 2025-2026 Calendar of Meetings and Events was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

7.E. 2024-2025 Committee and Chairs

Board member J. Dale agreed to serve on the executive committee.

MOTION: On a motion by M. Gibson, seconded by E. Flores, the 2025-2026 Committees and Chairs were approved by a unanimous voice vote.

8. Finance Committee

8.A. Approval of Financial Statements through 5/31/2025 (ACTION)

The Executive committee reviewed the contributions report, statement of operations, statement of financial operations, and the general operating budget through 5/31/2025. The committee noted that overall financial numbers appear healthy with room for continued improvement.

MOTION: On a motion by T. Harrington, seconded by E. Flores, the financial statements were approved as submitted by a unanimous voice vote, and will be forwarded to the Board of Directors for approval.

8.B. Administrative Fee (up to 1.5%)

The committee reviewed the annual administrative fee of up to 1.5%, noting it supports organizational operations and is assessed on the Promise Fund based on trailing values as of September 30.

MOTION: On a motion by E. Flores, seconded by T. Harrington, the annual administrative fee up to 1.5% was approved as submitted by a unanimous voice vote, and will be forwarded to the Board of Directors for approval.

9. Advancement Committee (Information)

9.A. Foundation Giving Report

J. Hooten noted annual gifts, including continued support from US Bank, and reported strong performance in both annual and endowed scholarships.

9.B. President's Circle/Annual Giving Report

J. Hooten shared that the President's Circle campaign has doubled its donors since last year, with revenue increasing to over \$116,000.

9.C. Scholarship Subcommittee Report

The Foundation reported a record of over \$600,000 awarded to more than 400 students.

9.D. Santa Ynez Listening Party

The committee reviewed the Santa Ynez Listening Party, noting it was a successful event that broadened community engagement, had a positive impact on attendees, and resulted in increased donor support.

9.E. Nipomo and Guadalupe Listening Parties

The committee discussed hosting another event like the Santa Ynez Listening Party, with potential locations in Guadalupe or Nipomo.

9.F. Hancock Honors Update

J. Hooten reported Hancock Honors planning is progressing well, with food, entertainment, and programming in place. Sponsorships and donations total \$180,000 to date, with a goal of \$250,000, and a collective board gift will be requested.

10. Foundation Staffing Update – Alex Ruiz-Guerrero (Action)

MOTION: On a motion by E. Flores, seconded by T. Harrington, the Foundation staffing update for the role of Operations Coordinator, was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

11. Board Meeting – July 24, 2025 – Agenda Review (Action)

MOTION: On a motion by M. Gibson, seconded by T. Harrington, the committee approved the agenda for the next Board of Directors meeting by a unanimous voice vote.

12. Working Meeting – September 25, 2025 – Agenda Review (Action)

MOTION: On a motion by M. Gibson, seconded by E. Flores, the committee approved the next Board of Directors working meeting by a unanimous voice vote.
