ALLAN HANCOCK COLLEGE FOUNDATION FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING Minutes of June 27, 2018

A regular meeting of the Finance Committee was held on Wednesday, June 27, 2018, at 10:30 AM at Allan Hancock College, 800 South College Drive, Bldg. B — Board Room, Santa Maria, California.

Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

Minutes of March 28, 2018

Chair Owen asked the committee to review the minutes of March 28, 2018 and called for a motion to approve.

Approval of Foundation's 2018-19 Operating Budget (ACTION)

Each year the Finance Committee reviews and approves a proposed operating budget for the upcoming fiscal year. Staff develops the preliminary budget using projections for both revenue and expense.

Ms. Houghton presented the proposed operating budget addressing the revenue and expenses of the budget. The proposed revenue is \$384,766. After discussion, the committee recommended increasing the Contributions to \$75,000 and decreasing the Administration Fee – 1.5% from \$80,000 to \$70,000 until the guidelines of the U.S. Department of Education's Title III Grant's 20-year term are met—the grant's term ends on September 30, 2018.

Also, Ms. Houghton reviewed the proposed expenses with the committee which includes an increase to staff's cash-in-lieu benefit from \$3,800 to \$5,000 annually, and a step-increase to the Advancement Specialist's salary. The committee was reminded the Title V grant will continue to reimburse the foundation for the Advancement Specialist position. Title V grant for the position will end funding on September 30, 2019. The committee recommended increasing Brokerage Fees from \$4,000 to \$13,000,

and a \$13,500 increase to Title III Scholarship & Program funding until the U.S. Department of Education's Title III Grant's 20-year term are met.

After further discussion, the committee recommended tabling the approval of the foundation's 2018-19 operating budget until income and expense augmentations have been completed. A special-called Finance Committee was scheduled for Tuesday, July 3, 2018, via teleconference to approve the revised 2018-19 operating budget.

Approval of Tentative 2018-2019 Foundation Budget for District (ACTION)

Each year the foundation submits to the district for board approval a foundation budget encompassing all of the foundation funds – operating, restricted, scholarships, and endowment funds. The committee reviewed the proposed budget for 2018-19.

After discussion, the committee recommended augmentations to the revenue and expenses, the committee recommended tabling the approval of the 2018-2019 Foundation's District Budget until revisions have been completed. The budget will be reviewed for approval at the special-called Finance Committee scheduled for Tuesday, July 3, 2018.

Discussion of Gift Fees

The foundation's operating budget receives a 1.5% Administration Fee from the majority of endowment proceeds. Ms. Houghton handed out a *Community College Foundation Gift Fees Comparison* chart. The committee discussed and reviewed the chart. The agenda item will be presented at a later date for further discussion.

Discussion of Acceptable Investments

Ms. Houghton provided the committee with a *Gift Practice from Cannabis Industry Donors* handout which addresses acceptable practices of Cannabis Industry Donors for Cuesta College Foundation, Diablo Valley College Foundation and Citrus College Foundation. The three foundations presently do not have a cannabis policy, but most likely will review in near future. The committee discussed what are socially responsible donations and what is the legality of handling cannabis industry donors.

Reallocation of Executive Director's Salary (ACTION)

The foundation's 2017-18 general operations budget includes a \$48,568 expense item for the Executive Director's salary. The foundation recently received an email from Shelly Allen, Budget Analyst, on behalf of Michael Black, stating the district will not invoice the foundation for the salary expense. Dr. Walthers has requested the budgeted amount be transferred to a foundation *One-Time Funding* restricted fund. The purpose of the *One-Time Funding* restricted fund is for community outreach while promoting and advertising Allan Hancock College. The foundation's operating budget has supported the President's *One-Time Funding* since fiscal year 2013-2014.

The committee reviewed the provided 2017-2018 *One-Time Funding* restricted fund expenses. After review and discussion, the committee approved the transfer of \$48,568 from the operating budget into the One Time Funding restricted fund.

MOTION: On a motion by Director Frost, seconded by Director Cox, the Finance Committee approved a transferring the Executive Director's budgeted \$48,568 salary from the 2017-2018 operating budget to the *One-Time Funding* restricted fund.

Foundation Staff Benefits (ACTION)

The Foundation staff receives different types of benefits than district employees. In view of the fact foundation employees are not offered medical, dental or retirement benefits, a cash-in-lieu benefit is included in the salary package. The current cash-in-lieu benefit is \$3,800 annually. The last cash-in-lieu benefit increase was July 1, 2009. Prior approved increases were \$2,370 effective July 2007; and \$2,282, effective January 2005, annually. Since the 2009 increase, health care costs have risen significantly. Ms. Houghton reported the request for an increase was an agenda item at the Executive Committee meeting held on April 11, 2018. With a fiscal impact to the 2017-18 operating budget, the Executive Committee recommended the Finance Committee review and approve the increase to staff benefits.

Ms. Houghton handed out a *Benefit Summary* schedule of eleven California Community College Foundations. Nine of the foundations are an auxiliary, and two are independent foundations. Many of the foundation employees are classified as college employees, and are provided college benefits while the foundation reimburses the college. The committee will discuss restructuring staff benefits in the future.

After discussion, the committee recommended an increase to the annual cash-in-lieu benefit.

<u>MOTION</u>: On a motion by Director Frost, seconded by Director Cox, the Finance Committee approved increasing Foundation staff's cash-in-lieu \$3,800 benefit to \$5,000 annually, retroactive to January 1, 2018. Fiscal impact to the 2017-18 operating budget is \$1,800.

Reallocation of Inactive Scholarship & Restricted Funds (ACTION)

Staff reviewed inactive foundation scholarship and restricted fund. The committee reviewed the following funds:

- 1. AHC Nursing Scholarship 83132085 balance \$2.75
- 2. Charlene Combs Memorial Scholarship 83132415 balance \$125.
- 3. Nancy Jo Frazier Memorial Scholarship 83132563 balance \$2,285. The donors are deceased and the scholarship has not been awarded in many years.
- 4. Jim McDonald Memorial Scholarship 83132870 balance \$775. The scholarship was created by the college board of trustees' in tribute to Mr. McDonald's years of service as college trustee.
- 5. Poole Scholarship 83132920 balance \$500. Former foundation board member Bob Poole created the scholarship.
- 6. Start Here Scholarship 83133166 balance \$5,885. The scholarship was was set up several years ago by former Executive Director Jeff Cotter. There are current college staff who contribute via monthly payroll contributions.
- 7. AHC Basic Mathematics Skills 83122018 balance \$3,750. The fund was setup by retired math instructor Richard Shiers. The math department is seeking funding to support the annual math contests.

After reviewing the inactive scholarship and restricted funds, the committee approved transferring the AHC Nursing Scholarship and Charlene Combs Memorial Scholarship to the Hancock Promise. Further, the committee recommended transferring the Start Here Scholarship to the Hancock Promise after college staff contacts donors for approval. The committee recommended making final scholarship awards from the Nancy Joe Frazier Memorial Scholarship, Jim McDonald Memorial Scholarship and Poole Scholarship.

The committee recommended contacting retired math instructor Richard Shiers, donor of the AHC Basic Mathematics Skills fund, for approval of allocating the fund for the math department.

Review and Approval of Financial Statements

Director Owen presented reviewed the following financial statements with the committee:

Check Registers - 3/31/2018 and 4/30/2018.

Contributions Report – For the period of 7/31/2017 through 4/30/2018, the total contributions were \$2,351,258 which includes over \$1 million in Hancock Promise pledges.

Statement of Operations: For the period ending 4/30/2018, the fund balance for the period was \$26,454,077.

Balance Sheet: For the period ending 4/30/2018, the total liabilities and fund balance were \$26,465,857.

Summary of Portfolio: The Portfolio Summary dated 7/1/2017 through 4/30/2018, reflects \$1,273,711 in general operations, restricted and scholarship funds; \$11,765,742 invested in endowment funds, \$12,339,002 in the Patricia J. Boyd Fund, and net assets as \$26,454,077.

General Operations Budget: The General Operations budget dated 4/30/2018, the revenue for the fiscal year as \$600,650; the expenses as \$578,131; the ending fund balance as \$221,165.

Financial Overview: The Financial Overview budget dated 4/30/2018, Statement of Activity, net assets balance is \$26,454,077; Statement of Financial Position, total liabilities and net assets as \$26,465,857; and expenditures as \$1,982,350. Director reminded the committee this report and the Financial Overview Cash & Investments will be the only financial statements forwarded to the Executive Committee and the full board.

Financial Overview – Cash & Investments: The statement of financial position as of 4/30/2018 has a cash balance of \$1,040,734, investment balance of \$24,337,721, totaling \$25,378,455.

Discussion of Finance Committee New Members

The committee discussed increasing the committee with new members and recommended potential names. The discussion will continue at a future meeting.

Other Business

Ms. Seyfert, Supervisor – Auxiliary Accounting Services, provided a cash flow chart handout to the committee of 4/30/2018. The chart compared the pooled regular, Title III and STEM endowments balance of \$7,124,374, and the pooled Monarch Wealth Strategies and Morgan Stanley Select UMA balance of \$7,792,904. The pooled endowments total is less than the pooled investments total by \$668.530.

The Young Unrestricted Endowment book balance is \$845,712, and the Northern Trust – Young Investment balance is \$1,464,576. The Young Unrestricted Endowment total is less than the Northern Trust Young Investment by \$618,864. Book transfers to the operating budget from the endowment and not liquidating the Northern Trust investment represents the difference.

The foundation unrestricted, 83111200, account balance is \$275,132. The Foundation Office Account, 83111300, balance is -\$61,315. The Morgan Stanley Consulting Group Advisor investment balance is \$737,135 and is made up of unrestricted, restricted and scholarship funds. Ms. Seyfert stated the Foundation Office Account has a negative balance due to beginning the fiscal year with a negative fund balance of \$49,519.

Further, Ms. Seyfert explained to the committee the unrestricted funds reported on the financials and in the Operating Budget consists of three program funds: Unrestricted - 81111200, Foundation Office - 83111300, and the Foundation 40th Celebration - 83111400. The financial statements and operating budget reports do not break out each program code masking the negative fund balance in the foundation office account. The majority of the income posting is to the Unrestricted account due to proceeds generated from the Consulting Group Advisor Investment.

Ms. Seyfert addressed the need for cash to meet major year-end cash-flow needs. She stated the district will be billing for Hancock Promise Fall 2018 registrations which is approximately \$200,000, approximately \$500,000 in scholarships that were awarded at the May 2018 banquet will be processed in August, and the district bills the foundation for grants the foundation holds.

The committee discussed drawing down cash for the year-end cash flow need. To fund the August scholarships, the committee approved drawing down approximately \$350,000, which represents the book transfer of endowment proceeds, from the pooled endowment Morgan Stanley Select UMA investment. To meet cash flow needs of the unrestricted funs, the committee approved drawing down \$250,000 from Morgan Stanley Consulting Group Advisor

<u>MOTION</u>: On a motion by Director Cox, seconded by Director Frost, the committee approved drawing down approximately \$350,000 from Morgan Stanley Select UMA, and \$250,000 from Morgan Stanley Consulting Group Advisor to meet cash flow needs.

Approval of Foundation's 2018-19 Operating Budget (ACTION)

The foundation's operating budget is a function of the unrestricted assets of the corporation. The proposed 2018-19 operating budget is being presented today for review, discussion and approval. At the Finance Committee meeting held on June 27, 2018, the committee requested several revisions to the proposed 2018-19 operating budget's revenue and expenses. Since the committee's recommendation, the staff made the following revisions to the budget:

REVENUE

Unrestricted Contributions – Increased from \$20,000 to \$75,000.

Administration Fee — Decreased from \$80,000 to \$70,000 until the foundation meets the guidelines of the U.S. Department of Education's Endowment Challenge Grant — Title III. The grant's 20-year term ends on September 30, 2019.

F. Young Endowment – Decreased withdrawal \$140,000 to \$85,000. This represents a book transfer from the endowment's proceeds.

EXPENSES

Executive Director (Salary) - The \$50,000 expense salary was decreased from the budget. Per Dr. Kevin Walthers, on June 28, 2018, the district will not invoice for the foundation's share of the Executive Director of College Advancement's salary.

Staff salaries/Employee Benefits & Payroll Taxes – The expenses were decreased by not filling the vacant Administration Assistant position for three months. Included in the budget is a step increase for the Advancement Specialist position.

Operational Supplies - decreased from \$6,500 to \$4,000.

Food Supplies - decreased from \$10,000 to \$5,000.

Consultants, Service Contracts - decreased from \$19,500 to \$18,850.

Agreements (Scholarship Program) – Decreased by \$9,000, the scholarship program Academic Works will be paid by the Title V grant.

Brokerage Fees – The budget was increased to \$13,000 until the Title III guidelines are met.

Title III Scholarship & Program Funding – The budget was increased to \$13,500 until the Title III guidelines are met.

The total budgeted revenue is \$376,956; and the total budgeted expenses is \$376,958. The committee reviewed the revisions to the budget and approved.

<u>MOTION</u>: On a motion by Director Frost, seconded by Director Cox, the Finance Committee approved the foundation's 2018-2019 operating budget. The recommendation will be forwarded to the Executive committee, and the full board for approval at the Board of Director's quarterly meeting on July 26, 2018.

Approval of Foundation's 2018-19 Foundation Tentative Budget for District

Each year the foundation submits a foundation budget to the district that encompasses all of the foundation funds—unrestricted, restricted, scholarship and endowments. The budget is presented to the Board of Trustees for approval. At the Finance Committee meeting held on June 27, 2018, the committee requested several revisions to the proposed 2018-19 Foundation Budget for District. Since the committee's recommendation, the staff made the following revisions to the budget: The revised 2018-19 Foundation Tentative Budget for District is being presented today for review, discussion and approval.

INCOME

Contributions – Increased by \$255,000 for Hancock Promise campaign and Unrestricted. **Transfer In** – Removed from the budget. Transfer Out offsets the income.

EXPENDITURES

Hancock Promise Scholarship - A new line was to accommodate was added along with an increase of \$275,000

Salaries – Decreased by not filling the vacant Administrative Assistant position for 3 months. Employee Benefits & Payroll Taxes – Decreased by not filling the vacant Administrative Assistant position for 3 months.

Travel and Conference – A budget increase by \$40,000. The expense includes Community Activities for Foundation and President's Circle.

Building and Equipment - A budget increase by \$3,500 based on fiscal year 2017-18 expenses. **Maintenance Agreements (Scholarship Program)** - Decreased by \$9,000, the scholarship program Academic Works will be paid by the Title V grant.

Transfer Out/Other Outgo — Removed from the budget since Transfer In offsets the expense.

The budgeted revenue is \$3,387,020; and the total budgeted expenses is \$2,269,358. The committee requested "tentative" be removed from the description of the budget. After reviewing the budget, the committee recommended approving the revised 2018-19 Foundation Budget for District.

Support of Measure Y (ACTION)

At the foundation's Executive Committee meeting held on Wednesday, July 11, 2018, included was discussion on how the Allan Hancock College Foundation can support the Measure Y bond initiative.

Ms. Houghton mentioned other Foundations have financially supported bond initiatives at Santa Barbara City College, Cuesta College and Taft College. The Executive Committee recommended \$49,000 in support of *Friends of AHC – Yes on Measure* Y given that the foundation's purpose is to further the mission of the college. The Executive Committee directed the Finance Committee to review options. Ms. Houghton presented funding options for drawing down \$49,000 as follows:

Option 1 – The Hansen Memorial endowment is unrestricted and part of the pooled investment held at Morgan Stanley Select UMA. The principal balance is \$242,500 as of June 30, 2018. At the Finance Committee meeting held on June 27, 2018, the committee had already approved a draw down from the MS Select UMA pooled investment to fund scholarships awarded in August 2018. Option 1 is to increase this draw down by \$49,000 from MS Select UMA for a total of approximately \$364,000. As of June 30, 2018, the total ending balance of Select UMA was \$6,225,985.

Option 2 – The Young Unrestricted Endowment has a book value of \$850,444 as of May 31, 2018. The Northern Trust investment balance as of June 30, 2018 is \$1,453,786. Option 2 would be to draw down \$49,000 from Northern Trust.

After discussion, the committee approved a recommendation to the Executive Committee to provide \$49,000 to the *Friends of AHC – Yes on Measure Y.* Further, the committee chose Option 1 - a withdrawal from the unrestricted Hansen Memorial Endowment, which is part of the pooled

investment held at Morgan Stanley Select UMA account. The Hansen Memorial endowment is unrestricted and part of the pooled investment held at Morgan Stanley Select UMA. The principal balance is \$242,500 as of June 30, 2018.

BACKGROUND

Foundation staff has prepared the final U.S. Department of Education Challenge Title III Grant financial report for fiscal year 2017-2018. As of June 30, 2018, 54% of the proceeds were used for the scholarships and programs. When filing the report, a cover letter will be included with a request to be released from the 20-year grant. If that does not occur, the Foundation could repay an amount equal to 50 percent of the amount improperly expended which is approximately \$20,000.

The Foundation was awarded the grant in 1997. The 20-year grant was a 2-1 match where Title III provided \$500,000 and the match was \$250,000. The \$750,000 has been used to establish endowments in support of scholarships and programs. The Department of Education required the Foundation prepare and submit annual financial reports for the 20-year grant period. Specific federal grant guidelines were required including investment types and not expending more than 50 percent of the aggregate income earned.

In November 2016, the U.S. Department of Education notified the Foundation office stating the Foundation was not in compliance with the grant guidelines with 65 percent of the aggregate income expensed. While the Foundation has consistently filed annual financial reports, the Department of Education never notified the Foundation of report errors and acknowledged personnel changes within the department may have caused lack of responsibility. Furthermore, the U.S. Department of Education indicated a willingness to work with the Foundation by extending the grant term by 1 to 2 years.

The Foundation and College staff promptly took immediate measures to correct being out of compliance with the following actions:

- 1. Evaluate growth of the fund through fiscal year.
- 2. Immediate waived the 1.5% administrative fee assessed to the Title III endowments beginning 2016-17 fiscal year.
- 3. Use Foundation Operational funds in lieu of Title III scholarship/program funding. A \$13,500 increase to the General Operations budget.
- 4. The Foundation Operational funds included the brokerage fees accessed to the Title III endowments. An \$8,500 increase to the General Operations budget.

Staff has reviewed all Title III endowments and Donor Fund Agreements. In many cases, donors identified the path forward post grant period. However, there are unrestricted accounts that will be reviewed by the Finance Committee. A list of the Title III endowments and the Donor Fund Agreements will be available at the meeting for review.
