Subject: Update on Annual Endowment Funding	

BACKGROUND

With the close of September's books, Auxiliary Accounting is prepared to discuss the current state of the Foundation's endowments, which experienced losses in the previous six months. We will examine a proposal for projected endowment draws for FY2022-23 and discuss options for whether and/or how to backfill projected gaps in funding.
