





2. Are you currently teaching at a California community college?





3. What California community college do you primarily work at?








6. What is your current teaching status?










12. In the courses you have taught with an online component in the past year, which of the following elements did the course include?

13. Thinking only of the hybrid course(s) you have taught in the past year, on average, what proportion of the learning experience took place in person?






16. Are any of your courses on the Exchange?














29. How do you believe AI technology impacts the learning experience for students?
















