No, we continue to outreach to junior high, high schools, as well as provided career services to current and former Allan Hancock College students and alumni.

We added the California College Corps to our services, which allows students to volunteer and receive up to \$7,000 for a living stipend for their services. We had a total of 50 students in College Corps (11 Dreamers and 39 Non-Dreamers).

We hired Frankie Maldonado for the California College Corps and Heidi Khaykham as a Career Center Specialist.

4. What were your program successes in your area of focus last year?

The Cooperative Work Experience enrolled 442 students with 20 faculty advisors.

Pathway Home 2 created 82 resumes and completed 61 career assessments at the Northern SB County Jail. 23 courses were completed pre-release for Pathway Home 2. While 7 courses were completed post-release by former inmates.

Concurrent enrollment totaled 5,129 students for 11 high schools including 203 class sections.

17 students participated in SkillsUSA at Regional and State Competitions.

4,000 middle schools and high school students were served at the Career Exploration Day with 150 exhibitors.

Jobspeaker (online job board) has nearly 4,000 students and more than 2,500 employers registered on the platform.
