#### **Non-Sponsored Recruit**

The beginning of a corrections career and your first step to success starts with completing the Allan Hancock College (AHC) Deputy Probation Officer Academy Application Packet.

- It is your responsibility to complete the application packet and provide all required information.
- All application documents must be completed in black ink or typed.
- You must respond to all items and questions. If an item or question does not apply to you, write "N/A" (not applicable in the space provided for your response).
- Any application that is incomplete or missing information will not be processed and will be returned to the applicant for completion
- Independent / Non-Sponsored Recruits are responsible for all college registration and Academy fees. This recruit is eligible for hire by an agency while attending or after graduating from the Academy.

I understand and agree that this release, waiver, discharge, and agreement to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless applies to all loss, injury, illness, death, or damage to me or my property resulting from my participation and involvement in the Allan Hancock Joint Community College District, Law Enforcement Training Program, Deputy Probation Officer CORE Academy.
