## ADMISSION & NONRESIDENT MERIT STEPS

Complete the steps below to apply to Allan Hancock College and determine eligibility for the Nonresident Merit Scholarship for the 2026-2027 academic year.



FINANCIAL AID

### STEP 1 // // APPLY FOR ADMISSION

- Create a CCCApply account to apply to the college.
- Verify your identity using CA DMV Wallet (California residents) or ID.me (out-of-state students).
- Complete your Allan Hancock College application:
  - Apply for summer if you plan to enroll in summer classes. If not, apply for the fall term.
    - A. Once complete, you will receive a confirmation email from CCCApply. Within 48 hours, you will receive an acceptance email from Hancock with your myHancock username and your student ID# that we call an H#
    - B. Follow the instructions on the email to setup your myHancock student portal

### STEP 2 // // COMPLETE HANCOCK ORIENTATION

### STEP 3 // // ENROLL IN CLASSES

- Enroll in and complete at least 12 units each semester, with at least three units taken in person.
- **NOTE:** Students may not combine classes that are less than three units to meet the in-person requirement.
- All classes must be taken for a letter grade. CR/NC (Pass/No Pass) grades do not count toward meeting this requirement.



### STEP 4 // // COMPLETE FINANCIAL AID REQUIREMENTS

- Complete the 2026-2027 financial aid application.
- Enter school code 001111 on your application.
- Your myHancock portal will display any missing financial aid documents. Be sure to complete all required items.



### STEP 5 // // SUBMIT TRANSCRIPTS

- Submit high school transcripts (for recent graduates) or college transcripts (for transfer students).
