#### 4. \* AHC Revised Mission Statement [15] (Dal Bello)

D. Dal Bello presented information to the Senate about a new Mission statement proposed by IEC. A survey was sent out to faculty to vote on the proposed new Mission statement to comply with Accreditation. There were only 125 responses. Faculty stated that the proposed changes embraced several of the new initiatives that the College is engaged in; it did not speak to generally what Hancock represents to all stakeholders. The proposed mission statement was presented to College Council yesterday. The IEC is looking for feedback from the Senate. The College Mission, vision, philosophy statements address the broad-based service the College provides. Faculty suggested a short, succinct statement that is memorable and reflects the behavior, attitude, and culture of the College. A suggestion was to have a short, succinct statement and a list of College values that can be referred to by programs as they connect the

mission of the College to their overall program documents. This Mission statement is a draft that is still being vetted and will need to be approved for the Educational Master Plan.

### 9. \*AP 5011 Concurrent Enrollment [10] (Lamica)

(*Proposed changes regarding maximum credits attempted for concurrent students*) Changes include increasing the total number of units allowed and to permit 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders to take Hancock classes without having to go through the appeals process to get waivers. Discussion included concerns about the number of units taken and not passed could affect their financial aid. Counseling is against this change of allowing more units to be taken. Safety was a concern for Industrial Technology for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders. Math voted "no" to increasing the units. PFA said not to 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders without the waiver process. Social Sciences was against the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders with the waiver. Science was looking for the College Now list to indicate that specific courses has content might not be appropriate. Fine Arts did not have a strong disposition about the increased units, but concurred about content possibly not being appropriate for younger students. English stated that there was no strong feeling with either change. G. Phelan stated they had the same consensus as Social Sciences. Business stated that the units weren't a concern, but no to the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders because of legal issues. Student Rep stated that the ASBG was neutral for the units and against the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders without a waiver. M. Quaid-Maltagliati asked if a course was offered as concurrent enrollment and 10<sup>th</sup> graders were allowed, are they required to get a waiver if they attend the course on campus. C. Hite stated that Fine Arts only approves courses in concurrent enrollment that are appropriate. L. Manlo stated that faculty need to consider when they approve concurrent enrollment courses that they will be offered to younger students.
