7. *AP 7211 Equivalency to Minimum Qualifications [15] (Montanez-Rodriguez)

(Voting on approving new language that largely adjusts minimum qualifications for community education instructors)

Changes include making the language more effective and efficient within the parameters that are required. The Petition for Equivalency forms will be updated as well. C. Hite inquired whether this tool is currently used for concurrent enrollment faculty and if the process is the same. The response was yes. Questionable concurrent enrollment faculty applications are referred back to the department. Ideally, the application should come to the department first when initial concurrent enrollment documents are submitted. These applications are checked for signatures from the department. If there is no signature, they are sent back to the department. Petitions are to be reviewed within 24 hours. The local Hancock College Disciplines List supersedes the minimum qualifications standards set by the state. The CTE Toolkit has been approved in the spring that allows different kinds of training and allows for different considerations concerning GE education and specific discipline training.
