DOES	DOSE
<i>Does</i> is a form of the verb <i>do</i> . It means something like "perform," or "act," or "make." It ends with a z sound and rhymes with <i>fuzz</i> and <i>buzz</i> .	Dose is a much less common word. It means "a portion of medicine." It ends with an <i>s</i> sound and rhymes with close, as in "get close to her."
