<b>To</b> with one <b>o</b> means something like toward or at. It is also used before a verb to make an infinitive. (In an infinitive, the idea of the verb rather than the action of the verb may be the main point: Tomas expects <b>to</b> be home at midnight.)	Too with two o's means "also," or "more than enough."	Two is the number 2.
