


PARTS OF A PARAGRAPH



TOPIC SENTENCE:	This sentence tells the reader the main idea, or what the paragraph will be about. Ex: There are several health hazards linked to the eating of fast food.
1st SUPPORTING SENTENCE:	This sentence gives specific details relating to the main idea. Ex: Eating fast food is linked to a higher risk of obesity, depression, and digestive issues.
2nd SUPPORTING SENTENCE:	This sentence gives another specific detail relating to the main idea. Ex: Also, there is a greater risk of heart disease, type 2 diabetes, cancer, and early death.
3rd SUPPORTING SENTENCE:	This sentence gives more specific details relating to the main idea. Ex: Further, research shows that even one fast food meal can lead to increased blood pressure, a drop in blood sugar, and increased inflammation throughout the body.
CONCLUSION SENTENCE:	This sentence refers to the topic sentence and sums up the main idea of the paragraph. Ex: Clearly, eating fast food is an unhealthy habit and should be avoided.
